- d. Financial Aid: Kelly Osorio, Director of Student Financial Services introduced two students to talk about the benefits of their financial aid and scholarships and the opportunity to focus more on learning. Osorio spoke about the changes that have been happening in federal financial aid including: national forbearance, public service loan forgiveness, fresh start initiative, loan debt forgiveness, proposed repayment term changes (see attached slide deck).
