a. Academic Planning



Bathroom and Locker Room Use Policy

The Bathroom and Locker Room Use policy has been revised consistent with the Commonwealth's new Public Accommodation Law, which requires places of public accommodation to permit the use of public facilities, including bathrooms and locker rooms, based on a person's sincerely held gender identity. This policy was revised in consultation
